

Single Adult Ministries Council

Purpose:

To implement the mission statement of the Single Adult Ministry which is stated as follows: The Single Adult Ministry of Aversboro Road Baptist Church is committed to meeting the total needs of single people in our church and community by equipping them for spiritual growth and ministry, supporting them through activities and fellowship; thus enabling them to be all God wants them to be.

Membership:

The Single Adult Ministries Council consists of two (2) at-large congregational representatives, both nominated by the Nominating Committee and elected by the church for a one year term. Both shall be eligible for re-election when nominated and duly elected. Also serving on this council for a one year term are representatives from each of the following demographic groups: 1) Single Never Married, 2) Single Again and 3) Single Parents. The majority of the council membership shall be single members but married people may be elected/appointed if uniquely qualified for single adult ministry. Membership on this council shall be limited to ten (10) people. The council chair and other officers shall be elected by the council. The Associate Pastor to Adults serves as an ex-officio member.

Relationships:

Council assists the church in fulfilling the Church's Mission: To proclaim the Gospel of Jesus Christ and to minister to the needs of our congregation, the community, and the world through the leadership of the Holy Spirit. This council shall utilize the five Biblical Functions of Worship, Fellowship, Discipleship, Ministry, and Evangelism in meeting the council's purpose and duties and in communicating, coordinating and cooperating and collaborating with others.

Duties:

1. Hold a council meeting early in the year to organize and develop plans and objectives for the year.
2. Prepare and submit a budget in accordance with Budget and Finance Committee procedures sufficient to support the Single Adult Ministry.
3. Prepare an agenda for and hold council meetings as required, or at least quarterly.
4. Conduct activities, programs, ministries conducive to the council's purpose.
5. Provide a written report of council deliberations, activities and recommendations to the Church Council.

6. Recommend to the Church Council coordinated plans for activities involving the single adult population of the church.
